



## Bare-root Deciduous Ornamental Trees

Standard tree height varies with the characteristics of each species but is usually in the range of 1-2m. **Super grade** trees are from the same batch as the **Regular** but are the larger trees of that line. **Advanced** trees are older than the Standard trees with the super grade ones again being the stronger of the line. **Farm Grade** trees are first year seedlings for mass planting (with appropriate care), potting up etc, with a minimum of order of twenty trees per line (for farm grade only).

## Tree Supply Information

### Tree Supply

Tree Supply is generally made during the period mid July - September.

### Open Hours

By appointment (being a working farm it is hard to maintain regular office hours). Effort is made to respond to telephone messages, faxes and e-mails promptly.

### Enquiry

Telephone, fax and e-mail enquiries are welcome year round. However please be aware that we must sometimes draw a line between giving information about product and giving information about trees, tree farming, and establishment generally, when this can be properly considered Consultancy.

### Ordering Trees

Trees may be ordered by telephone, fax, e-mail or mail. Please remember to specify size/price class.

### Order Confirmation

A deposit of 10% is required to confirm your order. Written confirmation advice of your order and deposit will be provided.

### Freighting Orders

Your order can be freighted to you on overnight transport. Cost is 10% of order total, with a \$35 minimum charge. We will provide you with prior notice of despatch date.

### Picking Up Orders

By appointment only. Please give 24 hours notice.

### Will they fit?

You may be surprised how small a bundle your order fits into as bareroot trees nest together well and their branches can be tied up against their stems. Even 3 metre trees will fit into most cars when poked from the back through to in between the front seats.

### What to bring

The roots of bare rooted trees should not be allowed to dry out. It is a good idea to bring some hessian or other material that can be used to put damp over the roots. If transporting in open utilities or trailers please bring a tarpaulin to wrap the roots. Damp Hessian Bags can be purchased at the nursery for \$3 each.

### Wrapped Roots

Bare roots can be glad-wrapped in damp shredded newspaper. This will protect trees for a number of days.

### Cash & Carry

A selection of our range is generally available for immediate sale at our despatch area from mid July to September. An appointment is necessary to ensure service.
